



# WePrint™ Lip Balm Label Instructions

## Preparation

- Labels should be applied to a clean surface free from wax or oils. Use dish soap or rubbing alcohol to clean the container surface. Allow container to fully dry before applying labels.
- If you are making your own lip balm, allow the filled containers to cool completely before applying labels. Labels exposed to heating and cooling can wrinkle, stretch, or peel off

## Applying Labels

**Note:** We recommend that you apply a test label to practice your application technique. You may need to adjust your label alignment, so don't press your label down firmly until you are satisfied with the placement.

**PEEL**  
Peel from this side

**ALIGN PERFORATION WITH CAP BOTTOM**

**PRESS DOWN ALONG CENTER**

**ROLL CONTAINER TO APPLY LABEL**

Always peel from bottom right corner. Peel carefully to ensure you don't break the safety seal.

Hold the label up to the container to ensure proper alignment.

Press down lightly along the center from top to bottom.  
Adjust alignment as needed.  
Once satisfied with the alignment, press firmly.

Roll container to apply label.  
Note: Depending on the size of your container, your label may overlap at the ends. You can account for this when creating your design.
